
Jack the Ripper crime series


The linkage charts show the degrees of similarity between cases. Value of similarity is between 0 -1, with values of 1 equating to absolute parity / 100% similarity. Values can also be considered as percentages (e.g. .64 = 64%).

Icons are indicated by victim's initials and the black coloured icons solely highlight the canonical five to this complete crime series.

The 'Control' and 'Style' offence behaviours in the linkage chart (slide 3) allowed the comparison of crime details against incomplete offences (e.g. Elizabeth Stride and Frances Coles – interrupted by a third party – Not all violence behaviours presented).
