My sister was wearing in the Cambora - a brown dress - figured black velvet jacket and above it a small woollen tucker. Shewn part of a tucker - Inventory $\frac{5}{2}$ - It is part of the tucker she was wearing. It is partly burned. I was shewn it by the police in Dundee. I never saw my sister alive again. I came to Dundee to identify the body. I went with Lieut. Lamb to Mortuary on 15th February and identified the body. Shewn Label 8 - Ulster. It is my sister's. My sister was /
