

Found charred remains of clothing in fire place. Articles noted in Inventory N^o 5. Label 8. Ulster. It was part of the packing of the body in box. Rest of packing was boots and clothing and paper.

Found agreement produced and identified in pocket of man's jacket in a portmanteau. We saw the body taken to mortuary. Dr Templeman took chief part in taking body out of ~~me~~. I shewed the body to the witnesses who identified it and I was present at post mortem examination by the Doctors. There was a broken pane in the back window of the room where body found

cross-examined - Outside stair down to Prisoner's house of ten or twelve steps. Floor of both rooms wood. There was a rug in the front of the fireplace of back room. It seemed the only room used. Front room empty.
